

To participate in this program, you must be a lawful permanent resident of the United States (4 years and 9 months or 2 years and 9 months if married to a U.S. Citizen) and speak, read, and write English, unless otherwise exempted under the law.

The United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW) is committed to providing the best possible assistance to applicants eligible for naturalization. However, in this setting, it is not possible to provide a complete analysis of all the details of an applicant's case. The information provided by the UFCW should not be used as a substitute for legal advice specific to the facts of your case. This questionnaire is an important tool to help you evaluate whether you are eligible or not for naturalization. To assist you, you must provide us with true and accurate information. If you decide to apply for naturalization without seeking such legal advice, you might be placed in removal proceedings and possibly lose your status, as a resident or be deported.

I also agree to waive any liability claim against the United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW), their officers, staff and agents for any consequences resulting from any of my mistakes and/or misrepresentations in my naturalization application. I also agree that the UFCW may copy my application and share my information for educational purposes or for research relating to the effectiveness of the Union Citizenship Action Network Program, on a confidential basis, but for no other purposes, without my express consent. UFCW reserves the right to track information on the progress of your application (receipt, appointments, and oath) in order to determine the efficiency of the program as a whole. In addition, a UFCW partner organization may file a notice of representation (G-28) for the sole purpose of filing the application except in mutually agreed circumstances. I acknowledge that I understand the waiver described in this document.
